Director's Report - Art Welch

The Park has been relatively quiet during the last month. There have been a few evening phone calls that have given us the opportunity to check our new radios. They are working great and get people out quickly to respond to what is happening. There have been no activities lately at Lot 235. Art left early for a doctor's appointment and Brad Couch took over the meeting.

Grant Report – Chris Spicer

We have received approval for expenditures. The Phoenix department is low on staff and slow in operations. We asked for reallocation of about \$600.00 for computers for Art and Sandy. We will be buying more paper and ink for the newsletter. We are also trying to get Police Neighborhood Patrol Signs. In May/June we will be working on grants for next year. The lighting at the front of the Clubhouse is complete. Lights by the Shuffleboard Court have had the electric turned off and will need to be turned back on by the city.

Report on PLV Directory – Chris Spicer

The Directory should be finished in about two weeks. Sylvia is in the process of the final proofing. Teri Strayer, Board Secretary, will be back by Tuesday and give the final approval so they can begin printing.

Old Business

Our Block Watch Captains list needs to be updated and Bob Heckman's zone will need a replacement by this fall. There is also a need to improve attendance at the monthly meetings. We will be passing out cards with summer information.

Block Watch Members donated ingredients including ice cream, toppings, cookies/brownies, root beer, and paper goods.
